Existing system has a lot of problems regarding the operations, which are performed on the daily basis. The response time of the existing system is very poor regarding some operations. The school has to manage all the records of student and their staff. In the existing system, it is very difficult to retrieve the information of a particular student. When an old student wants to retrieve any information about him or herself then it is a tedious task for the office staff.

To help promote students for their achievement and success, school must have access to complete and accurate information in time. One of the benefits of automated system is that the student record system will simplify retrieval of required information and is a great instrument for school

improvement by taking measures from the information acquired. The school is using paper based documentation system for performing various task and the school administrators apply their knowledge of hit and miss approach in scheduling classes and courses which is a sheer waste of manpower and much time unnecessarily that does not utilize the current technology.

Allotment of section and roll to the student is very difficult for the staff. Teacher may want to associate a student with his parent or emergency persons for disciplinary measure which need searching of the students record in the record office. It has been difficult to search a record from thousands of such records and it been observed that student can take any person claiming that he/she is their parent or emergency person which creates a problem in control of student.

Due to inefficiency of the current manual system, the need arises to automate system in order to efficiently handle student's information and allot section and roll number to students.

Currently the process of admissions are carried manually, maintaining section and roll number to all the students is tedious and time consuming work process which turns into loss of time and manpower to the school.

The need of the system is as follows:-

- Need a proper GUI for the new system to work efficiently.
- Need to generate quick response to any enquiry, so that student does not have to wait for long.
- Easy maintenance.
- Increase efficiency.
- More secured.
- Reduced manual work.

1.3 Scope of the Work

The aim of school management system is to automate the process of school management. Reduce the tedious work of store and save the information of student. We need to enter, store and search huge amount of information related to large number of students and teachers from the school. Our system reduces the work load of system by automating all the related processes electronically. This system not only automates the data entry for student details but also maintains the student section and rolls number.

- **Registration:** - This module is used for maintaining the details of student during the Registration Process. Registration process will be happened after the Enquiry process. The student who has done Enquiry can eligible for Registration process.

- **Admission:** - This module is used for maintaining the details of student during the Admission Process. Admission process will be happened after the Registration process. The student who has done Registration can eligible for Admission process. During the Admission process students have to fill all personal, parents, address, health and other details.
- **Admission Cancellation:** - This module is used for maintenance of cancellation detail of a student.
- **Allotment of Section and Roll Number:** - This module is used for allotment of section and rolls number to the students.
- **Document Upload:** - This module is used for uploading the document of student by Admin.
- **Class Teacher Allotment:** - This module is used for allotment of class teacher to a particular class.
- **Define Master :-**
 - a) **Class:** - With the help of this module Admin can add and update a class in particular session.

- b) Section: - With the help of this module Admin can add and update a section in particular class.
- c) Session: - With the help of this module Admin can add and update a session.
- d) Stream: - With the help of this module Admin can add and update a stream.
- e) Nationality: - With the help of this module Admin can add and update nationality.
- f) Notice and Event: - With the help of this module Admin can add and update Notice and Event.
- g) Admission Schedule: - With the help of this module Admin can add and update Admission Schedule.

J2EE

The Java 2 Platform, Enterprise Edition (J2EE) defines the standard for developing multitier enterprise applications. The J2EE platform simplifies enterprise applications by basing them on standardized, modular components, by providing a complete set of services to those components, and by handling many details of application behavior automatically, without complex programming.

The J2EE platform takes advantage of many features of the Java 2 Platform, standard edition (J2SE), such as "Write Once Run Anywhere" portability, JDBC API for database access, CORBA technology for interaction with existing enterprise resources, and a security model that protects data even in internet applications. Building on this base, Java 2 Platform, Enterprise Edition adds full support for enterprise

JavaBeans components, java Servlets API, Java Server Pages and XML technology.

The J2EE standard includes complete specifications and compliance tests to ensure probability of applications across the wide range of existing enterprise system capable of supporting the J2EE platform.

JSP

Java Server Pages (JSP) is a java technology that helps software developers serve dynamically generated web pages based on HTML, XML, or other document types. Released in 1999 as Sun's answer to ASP and PHP, JSP was designed to address the perception that the Java programming equivalent didn't provide developers with enough support for the web. JSP syntax is a fluid mix of two basic content forms: Scriptlet elements and markup. Markup is typically standard HTML or XML, While Scriptlet elements are delimited blocks of java code. This may be intermixed with the markup. When the page is requested the java code is executed and its output is added, in situ,

with the surrounding markup to create the final page. JSP pages must be compiled to Java byte code classes before they can be executed, but such compilation is needed only when a change to the source JSP file has occurred.

The JSP syntax adds additional XML-like tags called JSP actions, to invoke built in functionality.

Apache Tomcat (or Jakarta Tomcat or simply Tomcat) is an open source servlet container developed by Apache Software Foundation (ASF). - To maintain the record of student transfer certificate.

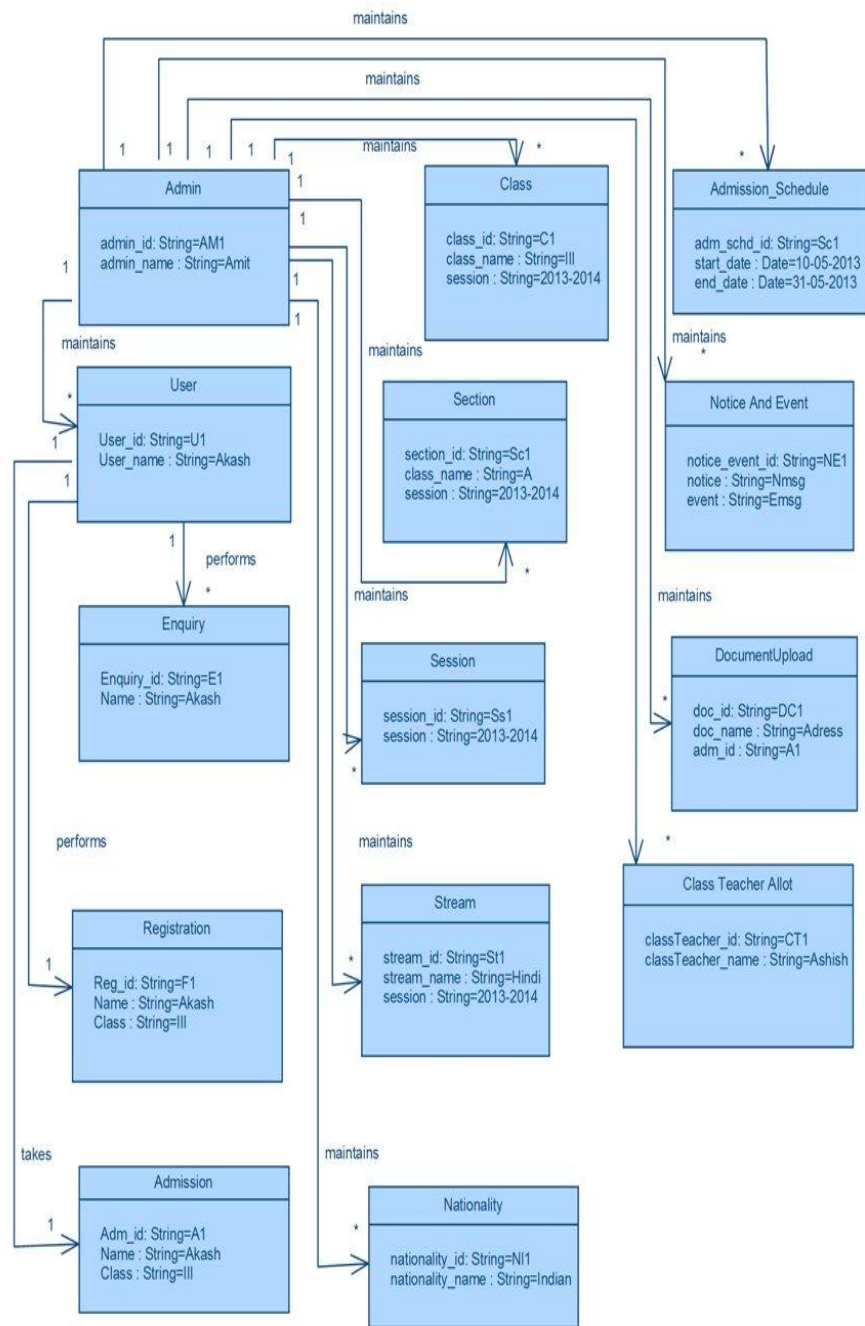

3.14 Test Procedures and Implementation

What is software testing?

Software testing is a critical element of software quality assurance and represents the ultimate review of specification, design and code generation. It is a process of executing a program with a primary objective of finding errors. Testing gives the guarantee that the software does not fail and runs according to its specifications and in the way the end user expects.

Testing procedure

Testing will be performed by running the program using the test data. Testing is vital to the success of the system. It will also test whether the system identify the problem correctly.

The following software testing techniques were used in order to uncover errors in the system:

- Unit testing
- Integration testing

- White box testing
- Black box testing
- Acceptance tests (Alpha and Beta testing)

1: Unit Testing

Unit testing is normally considered as an adjunct to the coding step. It is the test for the small units of code, e.g. programs, modules or procedures, in order to ensure that they perform their intended functions. Unit testing is also done to test the data flow across a module interface.

The following errors are uncovered during unit testing:

- Comparison of different data types.
- Incorrect logical operators or precedence.
- Incorrect comparison of variables.
- Improper or nonexistent loop termination.
- Improperly modified loop variable.

2: Integration Testing

Integration testing is a systematic technique for constructing the program structure while at the same time conducting tests to uncover errors associated with interfacing. During this activity, unit tested components are taken and a program structure is built as per the design. Then incremental integration is performed on the system. This means that programs are constructed and tested in small increments instead of testing the entire program as a whole. This is done because correction of errors becomes difficult in case of whole program testing as many errors were detected and it is not easy to correct them at one go. Thus, through incremental integration testing, any error uncovered could be easily noted and corrected and interfaces are tested completely.

3: White Box Testing

White box testing is also called as glass box testing. It is related with the structure (internal logic) of the program. It helps in uncovering many errors that black box testing cannot. During white box testing

activity, every statement of programs is executed at least once. All independent paths are also executed.

4: Black Box Testing

Black box testing, also known as behavioral testing focuses on the functional requirements of the software. It is related to input and output only and not related with the internal structure of the program. This testing is also done so as to find errors such as:

- Initialization and termination errors
- Behavior and performance errors
- Incorrect or missing functions
- Interface errors
- Errors in data structures and external database access

5: Acceptance Testing (Alpha & Beta Testing)

An acceptance test is a test carried out by the customer or end user rather than the developer in order to enable the customer to validate all requirements. Alpha testing and beta testing are two types of acceptance tests that are conducted.

6: Alpha Testing

Alpha test is conducted in a controlled environment. As a matter of fact, the end user conducts alpha test at the developer's site. During the course of the system development, the end user is operating the software in front of the developer and the errors and other problems are recorded. Rectification is made accordingly.

7: Beta Testing

Beta testing is also conducted by the end user, but in the absence of the developer. Here, the end user himself records all the problems that he encounters during testing the system and then reports them to the developer at regular intervals. As a result of problems reported during beta testing, modifications are made to overcome the problem.

Chapter 4

USER MANUAL

4.1 User Manual

This user manual is for the user's ease and to guide and help to use the Admission System. User will find the system very user friendly. The user doesn't need to have depth knowledge of programming and computing only basic knowledge of computer and windows required.

You can use various menus for doing particular work. Menus are present at the top, left and bottom side of the pages.

At the top of the page menus like Home, Admission, About us and Contact. In the Admission Menu user can perform enquiry. And also user can view Admission Schedule and Seat Availability. User can perform Registration and Admission Process during the schedule specified by the Admin. User can also view availability of seats. If seats are available then students are eligible for Registration and Admission process.

At the bottom of page, there are two types of login is available. First login tab is available for Head and second login tab is available for Admin.

If Head logins into the system, he can perform various maintenance of Master like Class, Section, Stream, Session, Nationality, Event and Notice, Admission Schedule etc.

If Admin logins into the system, he can perform various tasks like update student information, upload and update student documents, cancel admission of students, issue Transfer Certificate etc.

4.2 Operations Manual / Menu Explanation

Home and Login:-

Menu displays home page of the website. There will also have the login screen on the right hand side where Admin and Head of school can login with their username and password. Visitors are not allowed to log in they only can have look at the home page. And they can perform enquiry process. After the enquiry process, they are eligible for registration and admission process.

Both username and password are mandatory. This menu and page displayed only two times after log out and before log in.

Logout:-

After every successful login the Head and Admin can see the link at top-right hand side naming Log Out. They can logout from the system at any time. Note that no successful logout message is displayed to them

Admission:-

At the top of the system menu named Admission is there. With the help of this menu user can perform Enquiry Process. They can also view admission schedule and seat availability. If schedule date lies between current dates then after they are eligible for Registration and Admission process.

Head:-

If Head is logged in, he will be able to perform following maintenance tasks:

- **Maintain Class**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Class. With the help of this option Head can add and update Class. If all Classes are defined then after user is eligible for taking admission for that class.

- **Maintain Section**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Section. With the help of this option Head can add and update Section.

- **Maintain Session**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Session. With the help of this option Head can add and update Session. If all Sessions are defined then after user is eligible for taking admission for that session.

- **Maintain Stream**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Stream. With the help of this option Head can add and update Stream. If all Streams are defined then after user is eligible for taking admission for that stream.

- **Maintain Nationality**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Nationality. With the help of this option Head can add and update Nationality.

- **Maintain Notice and Event**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Notice and Event. With the help of this option Head can add and update Notice and Event.

- **Maintain Schedule**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Schedule. With the help of this option Head can add and update Schedule.

- **Maintain User Registration**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu User Registration. With the help of this option Head can assign user name and password to the Employee.

Admin:-

If Admin is logged in, he will be able to perform following maintenance tasks:

- **Edit Student's Information**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Edit Student. With the help of this option Admin can update student's information.

- **Admission Cancellation**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Admission Cancel. With the help of this option Admin can cancel the admission of student.

- **Transfer Certificate**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Transfer Certificate. With the help of this option Admin can issue the transfer certificate of student.

- **Upload Document**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Upload Document. With the help of this option Admin can upload the document of student.

- **Update Document**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Update Document. With the help of this option Admin can update the document of student.

Report:-

This option is used to view various types of reports. Reports can also be printed by the button at the below of report.

4.3 Program Specifications

Home and Login:-

This Menu with home page will be displayed when user enters specified URL (<http://localhost:8080/SchoolErp/>). There will also have the login screen on the right hand side where Admin and Head of school can login with their username and password. Visitors are not allowed to log in they only can have look at the home page. And they can perform enquiry process. After the enquiry process, they are eligible for registration and admission process.

Logout:-

After every successful login the Head and Admin can see the link at top-right hand side naming Log Out. They can logout from the system at any time. Note that no successful logout message is displayed to them.

Admission:-

At the top of the system menu named Admission is there. With the help of this menu user can perform Enquiry Process. They can also

view admission schedule and seat availability. If schedule date lies between current dates then after they are eligible for Registration and Admission process.

Head:-

If Head is logged in, he will be able to perform following maintenance tasks:

- **Maintain Class**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Class. With the help of this option Head can add and update Class

- **Maintain Section**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Section. With the help of this option Head can add and update Section.

- **Maintain Session**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Session. With the help of this option Head can add and update

Session. If all Sessions are defined then after user is eligible for taking admission for that session.

- **Maintain Stream**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Stream. With the help of this option Head can add and update Stream.

- **Maintain Nationality**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Nationality. With the help of this option Head can add and update Nationality.

- **Maintain Notice and Event**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Notice and Event. With the help of this option Head can add and update Notice and Event.

- **Maintain Schedule**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu to add Schedule. With the help of this option Head can add and update Schedule.

- **Maintain User Registration**

At the left hand side of Head page, there is a menu User Registration. With the help of this option Head can assign user name and password to the Employee.

Admin:-

If Admin is logged in, he will be able to perform following maintenance tasks:

- **Edit Student's Information**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Edit Student. With the help of this option Admin can update student's information.

- **Admission Cancellation**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Admission Cancel. With the help of this option Admin can cancel the admission of student.

- **Transfer Certificate**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Transfer Certificate. With the help of this option Admin can issue the transfer certificate of student.

- **Upload Document**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Upload Document. With the help of this option Admin can upload the document of student.

- **Update Document**

At the left hand side of Admin page, there is a menu Update Document. With the help of this option Admin can update the document of student.

Report:-

This option is used to view various types of reports. Reports can also be printed by the button at the below of report.

Drawbacks and Limitations

The current system suffers from few drawbacks and limitations which are listed below:

- If accidentally, the Admin forgets his userid or/ and password, in that case there is no any 'UserID & Password Recovery Procedure' that would help him recover his ID and passwords.
- User can perform Registration process with the help of email id. If user forgot email id then he/she is not able to take admission.
- User doesn't take admission directly. Before Admission process he/she will have to perform enquiry and registration process.
- The current system lack of SSL security encryption technique.

Proposed Enhancements

Password Recovery

If password recovery module is introduced Admin can get his user name and password.

Send Email/SMS

If Send Email/SMS module is introduced Admin can send acknowledgement to the user with the help of Email or SMS.

Enquiry

In this system user can perform N number of enquiry. The same user can perform Enquiry process again with different Email Id. With some enhancement in the system Admin can restrict the user to perform enquiry process again

Conclusions

I feel very glad to conclude this report. This is my first experience to perform such professional work. Objective of this work was to satisfy user's requirement, successful implementation of the system, designing a user friendly and easy to operate system. 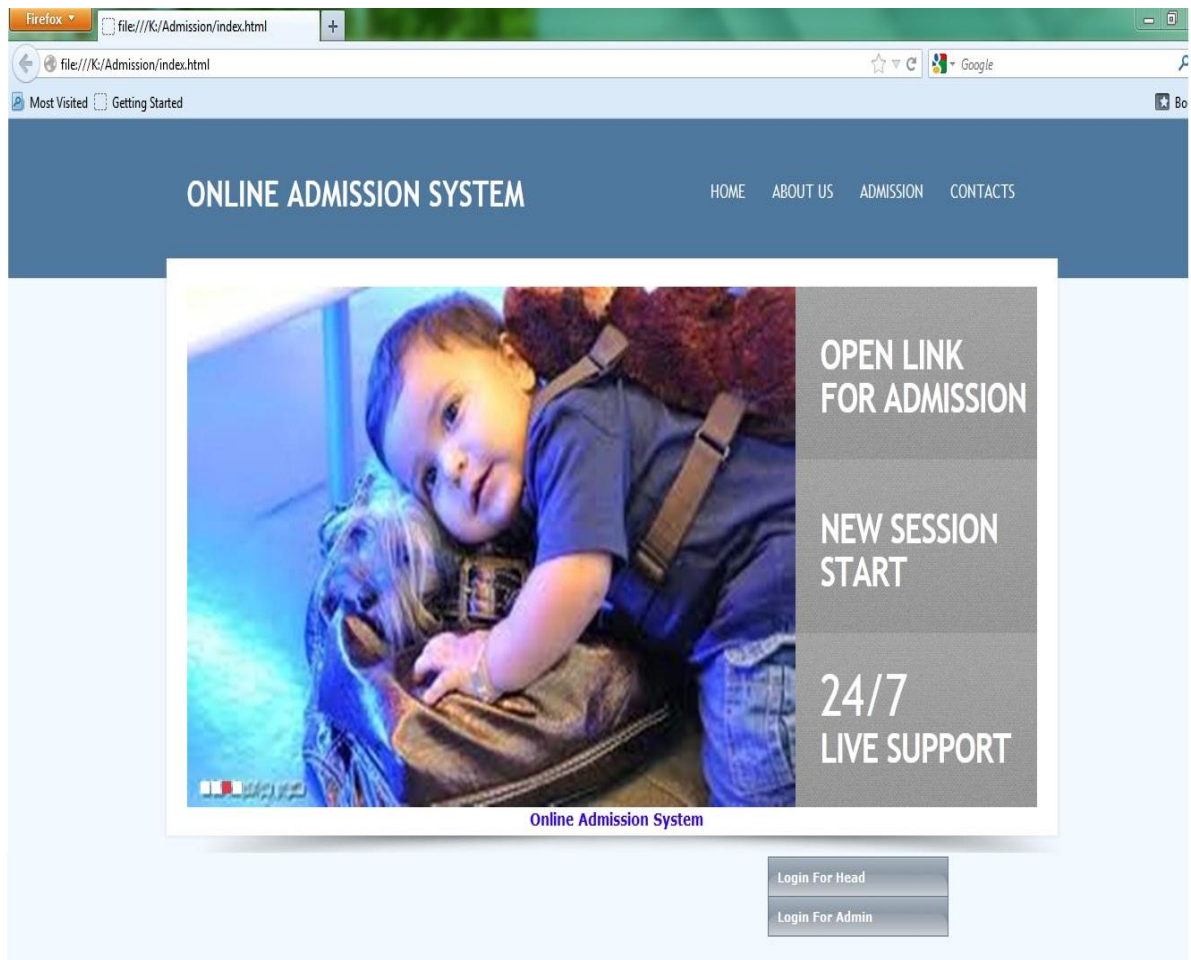

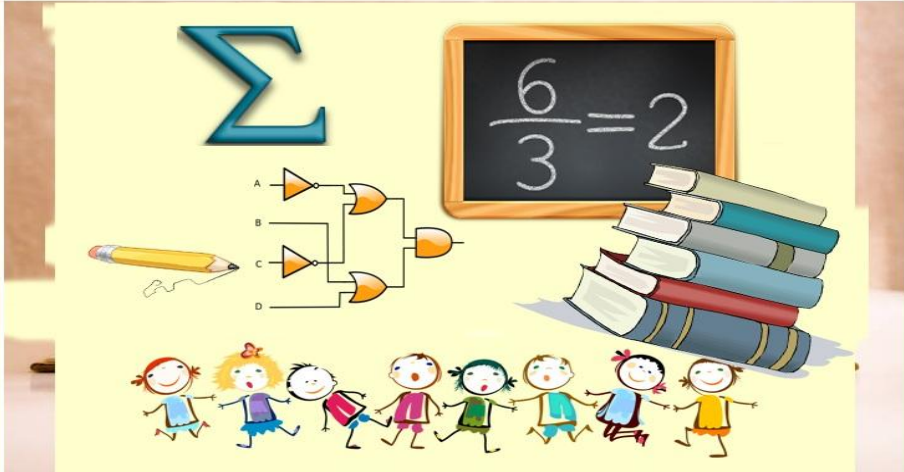
