

The MVC pattern helps you create applications that separate the different aspects of the application (input logic, business logic, and UI logic), while providing a loose coupling between these elements. The pattern specifies where each kind of logic should be located in the application.

- The UI logic belongs in the view.
- Input logic belongs in the controller.
- Business logic belongs in the model.

This separation helps you manage complexity when you build an application, because it enables you to focus on one aspect of the

implementation at a time. For example, you can focus on the view without depending on the business logic.

Three tier Architecture:-

Three-tier architecture is a client—server architecture in which the user interface (presentation), functional process logic ("business rules"),computer data storage and data access are developed and maintained as independent modules, most often on separate platforms. The three-tier model is a software architecture pattern.

Apart from the usual advantages of modular software with well-defined interfaces, the three-tier architecture is intended to allow any of the three tiers to be upgraded or replaced independently in response to changes in requirements or technology. For example, a change of operating system in the *presentation tier* would only affect the user interface code.

And can be able to edit or update if required.





3.12 Web Site Map Diagram





3.16 Test Procedure and implementations

Definition:

A test case is simply a test with formal steps and instructions; test cases are valuable because they are repeatable, reproducible under the same environments, and easy to improve upon with feedback.

A test case is a detailed procedure that fully tests a feature or an aspect of a feature. Whereas the test plan describes what to test, a test case describes how to perform a particular test.

Unit Testing

This testing focuses verification on the module. Using procedural design description as a guide; important control paths are tested to uncover errors within the boundaries of the module. The relative complexity of tests and uncovered errors is limited by the constraints scope established for the unit testing. The unit testing can be conducted in parallel for the several modules.

Integration Testing

Generally a combined approach known as sandwich testing using features of top down testing strategy for the upper levels of the program structure, coupled with the bottom up strategy for subordinate modules.

Functional Testing

This is done for each module and sub module of the system.

Functional testing serves as a means of validation weather the functionality of the system confirms the original user requirements i.e. done the module do what is supposed to do. The separate schedules were made for functional testing.

System Testing

System testing is done when the entire system has been fully integrated. The purpose of the system testing is to test how the different modules interact with each other and whether the system provides the functionality that was expected.




4.1 User Manual

E school Management System is a web-based application, which is designed mainly for parents and students. It is way easy to handle. When user opens the website, he/she will be provided login screen, which is shown below




According to the username and password, a user can log in into the system as a student, as a teacher, or as a parent or as an admin. Each of this personality will be provide separate and unique username and passwords.

For example, admin can see information entered by the students and can add or delete them from the system.




This screen shows the students of particular class. Admin can update or delete particular information from here.

Like admin, students also have their work space available in the system. And that is student dashboard. It is shown in next screen.




It is kind of same as admin in terms of looks, but the functionalities are way different.


For example, students can look after their progress and school routines by themselves.



The student can see their regular class routine as shown in the above screen.


The basic concept was to include parents into the system. So down here parents added by the admin into the system.
