Best Practices

Application of Six Sigma in the library & information Center @ MES IMCC

The covid and post covid period is utilized by the library and information resource center to eliminate and streamline the processes to raise the effectiveness of the Library performance; ultimately to service the users in a more efficient manner by applying the six sigma technique. From the last 3 years, the six sigma technique is applied for the more effective performance for the information service delivery. Major areas covered for the performance improvement are the circulation section, administration section including the acquisition section, library stacks etc.

Extending the digital accessibility to electronic resources :

The IMCC Library has undergone a major upgrade in the online service due to the impact of COVID Pandemic all over the globe. During the post Covid period, from the last two years the library started purchasing additional e-journals and e-books useful for the students and faculty, through the variety of databases such as IEEE ASPP, World ebooks database through the DELNET National Consortium, ProQuest database, N-list and kopykitab.

Increasing the awareness about Electronic Resources:

A faculty members session on the institutional campus is conducted by Prof.(Dr.) Mrs Meenal Oak, librarian IMCC in order to increase the awareness level and the utilization by the faculty members. The session included the paid database and the open source databases awareness followed by an interactive Q&A based on the queries related to the research writing & publications, Impact factor, double blind peer review and UGC CARE list answered by Prof Meenal Oak.

It has created a positive impact on the students and also on the faculty members. The library uses the embedded librarianship approach and provides an online SDI service to the faculty members. The faculty members are proactively discussing the topics of interest and on the related areas of academic interest with the Librarian.

The library webpage has been continuously upgraded on the institutional website to provide access to the e-books and e-journals through the paid and open source online databases.








Autonomous programs of Library and Information Science by the MES, Pune India

Every year MES IMCC conducts the 2 batches of the SET/NET Training programme for the budding LIS professionals in the society. Basic aim is to provide proper guidance to the fellow library professionals, in order to prepare them for the SET/NET Examination by the *systematic conduction* of the theory and MCQ's sessions from the year 2015. Basic attitude of MES for grooming the learners and enthusiasm and quest for knowledge of earlier batches has encouraged us to continue with our efforts of providing

training for SET/NET examinations for the benefit of the library science profession. For this programme, the candidates registering from all over the Maharashtra from *Mumbai*, *Bhusawal*, *Aurangabad*, *Shengaon*, *Nashik*, *Ahamadnagar*, *Mangaon*, *Solapur*, *Bhusawal* and Pune and various places nearby Pune as *Manchar*, *Baramati*, *Khed* etc During the academic year 2021-22, the MES has conducted the 9th & the 10th SET/NET Workshop through a virtual mode. 


