
Best Practices

The library webpage has been continuously upgraded on the institutional website to provide access to the e-books and e-journals through N-List and other paid resources including the recommended titles of textbooks.







ProQuest Journals Providing select Management Science Journals




DELNET WOrld ebooks Database with more than 20 Lacs of e-books


Database through NDL (National Digital Library) & e-PG Pathshala : Projects of MHRD



Considering the impact of COVID-19 on the globe and on the academic profession as well, the MES IMCC- Maharashtra Education Society's Institute of Management and Career Courses in collaboration with the MUCTA Mumbai University and College Teachers Association organised a **Virtual International Developmental Programme for Librarians for** 7 days(during 24th May to 30th May 2020) with the focus of providing the guideline to LIS professionals by considering today's changing higher educational scenario. coming period henceforth in order to provide the services to the varied user

Programme was a good mix of the sessions practical tools and the attitudinal skills which are required to imbibe for building the overall personality of the Librarians for superseding the challenges in the coming period. The sessions were conducted on the current aspects requiring quick adoption from the academic professionals such as ZOOM platform, Scientific misconduct, Moodle applications, Document retention policy and Open access resources.

Program started with the welcome address of Dr Santosh deshapnde Director, MES IMCC and ended with the valedictory address given by Dr Bharat Vankate , Secretary MES on the 30th May 2020) The program got an overwhelming response. Total 3380 library professionals registered for the programme from India, United Arab Emirate (UAE), Bangladesh and Pakistan. The sessions were hosted by the Program Coordinator Dr. Mrs Meenal Oak, and Dr Subhas Athawale, an advisory Committee Member and Hon. General Secretary MUCTA.

The center is actively managed by the library and the staff of IMCC very enthusiastically under the direction of Dr Santosh Deshpande HOI IGNOU SC and the Director MES IMCC,Pune . The center has at present 1326 learners and runs MBA, BCA, BTS, MTTTM, BLIS, MLIS, PGDLAN CLIS, CBS, CIT on the campus under the coordinatorship of Dr Mrs Meenal Oak since January 2015.

Dr Mrs Meenal Oak as a Center Coordinator is responsible to coordinate, administer and manage activities of the center pertaining to counselling and marketing and entire administration of the programs with the support of Assistant Coordinators appointed for the different programs and the office staff . By considering the current scenario, the center has started conducting the sessions through online mode.

During the post covid period, the center was one of the nodal point to conduct virtual Viva of the LIS learners for the IGNOU. During the post covid period, the center has conducted the offline examinations on the campus for the 2300 learners registered for the exam.

sessions through the Google Classroom with the online submissions and the evaluation .


