Library and information canter, apart from the core library activities the library and information canter has taken a lead in managing the entire IGNOU study centre as well as the YCMOU library science programs in IMCC. From the year 2015, the centre is organising the SET NET Training Program is organised every year to guide the library science professionals in the Maharashtra State. At present, institute is running 7th batch of the SET NET Training Program. The institution has also launched prestigious One Year Postgraduate Diploma in Digital Library Management, Automation and Networking (PGDLIMAN). What is new?

KOHA Project Execution: New Developments

MES koha project started from last two years back, and is focused on an automation of library functions and services of the MES Institutional libraries using the cloud computing technique for the provision of accessibility to all the member libraries catalogue collection through a single access point. The project basically included coordination and exhecution of the activites focusing entire preparatory work of the databases of libraries collection involved in KOHA project involving even the library classification work, database formating and aligning the accessioning work and data migration as well in these libraries. During the second stage the WEB Libraries OPAC designing of MES is been done for the effective accessibility. Thus now all the member libraries' collection is available through *MES libraries koha web OPAC* (Web ID: http://mes-koha.informindia.co.in/)

During the academic Year 2018-19, three more member Institutions are added as *MES IMCC(MBA)*, *MES Night College*, *Karve Road*, *Pune and MES Senior College*, *Mayur Colony*, *Pune*. The MES Senior College is working now with koha including the circulation, acquisition and budgetary module, whereas for the remaining member institutions the work is under process.

fraternity to interact in a periodic manner on the various educational aspects. The


idea pool further is guiding the faculty members in browsing various titles on


various aspects not only of the domain but also of the related aspects of

selected collection on the day for the faculty members.



IMCC's Digital Institutional Repository:

A Digital Institutional repository using the d-space open library software developed and is accessible through the web-Id: http://192.168.2.156.8080/jspui.
It gives effective accessibility to the Summer Projects in e-format, question papers, syllabi, list of the research papers of the faculty memebrs etc. The library has developed a digital library section for the entire user community, especially the student segment. The digital library section provides access to the online databases and IMCC's Digital Institutional repository which consists of accessibility of the Summer Projects in e-format, question papers, syllabi. It has now focused on building up the photo collection of the organization.

Internet search and online e-resources

The library provides accessibility to the on-line resources through the N-list and the ProQuest Management Collection database. The library provides wi-fi network connectivity to the users for utilization of the laptops in the library reading hall.

Library Activities

User Orientation

Purpose of this activity is to raise the awareness level of the newly entrant students regarding the library services, resources and the library rules and regulations, library staff for maximizing the usage of library. Library Orientation for new entrants was conducted during the academic year 2019-20.

The library staff provides guidance to locate reading material and also to locate proper information form the library collection which helps the users in quick retrieval of the documents.

Library Kit

Library every year distributes the "Library Kit" to the newly entrant students consisting of manuals of Library Facilities and Services, Library Rules, along with current year Borrowers Tickets. It facilitates users to get acquainted with the library environment.

The library has focused the Continuous Improvement Principle. It has adopted the benchmarking through the application of the LibQual+ technique for the betterment of the library services to cope up with the needs of users' in the present scenario.

Training to LIS professionals in MES Institutions

IMCC has conducted the training programs for the LIS professionals of the member libraries under the MES koha project in the academic year 2019-20. A 2 days KOHA Library Software training program for the effective application of koha Library Circulation Module and OPAC utilization was conducted including the Bar coding, on-line Issue and Return transaction, creation and maintenance of the users record for the LIS professionals working in the remote areas of kokan.

Dr Santosh Deshpande, Director IMCC and the GB member MES, guided the participants as far as the KOHA Project is concerned for the quick application of koha. He highlighted the importance of library automation and the need to implement the koha in the MES environment. During the programme, the candidates raised the difficulties in the use of modules which were guided and solved by Dr Mrs Meenal Oak Coordinator MES koha Project

Effective use of ICT

The way of accessibility to information and changing user expectations due to ICT has a tremendous impact on the libraries. IMCC Library is continuously adopting the newer ways to cope up with the changing scenario and particularly the extended and ever changing expectations of the tech-savy users of computer and management science. PGDLIMAN

The second batch of the Post Graduate Diploma in Digital Library Management, Automation & Networking (PGDLIMAN) started in September 2019. An autonomous programme of *MES's IMCC*, *it* aims at developing the professional competencies of the library and information professionals in an automated and digital library networked environment. The first batch successfully completed the programme; the second batch is now being conducted in the canter.

The program focuses on in-depth practical sessions for building the technological skills of the students supported by required sessions on the theory, in order to develop them as an independent library manager who will manage the library in the new era successfully. The Libraries today are impacted tremendously by the digital and networked environment. ICT has a major impact on the storage functions and delivery of information in the library. The task ahead is a major challenge to handle the voluminous data in the digitized form and to manage it successfully for serving the user segments in an effective manner.

The objectives of the programme are to imbibe the knowledge of the basic requirements of library automation and automated library services with the major focus on Open Source Library Software systems such as D-space and KOHA; to provide the knowledge and skills on networking and Internet technology in particular to the library and information networks; to develop the Internet skills with special focus on the information resources available in different forms and subjects; to provide the knowledge and skills of web designing and the legal issues associated with electronic information; to enable the design and development of a programme by enhancing skills on programming based on the language C++; to undertake a practical based project in order to specialize in one of the thrust areas on library automation and networking.

The Programme is of high benefit to the qualified Librarians and all other working library professionals as well as the budding LIS candidates interested in upgrading the ICT Knowledge, skills and its effective application in the current automated and networked library environment. The programme is open to candidates with a minimum Bachelor's Degree in Library and Information Science (BLISc).

Dr Mrs Meenal Oak is the Coordinator of the progarmme.

YCMOU Study Centre

MES's IMCC is been approved as an YCMOU centre to run the academic programs in the Computer and Library science. The center has received a positive response as per the expectation by looking at the LIS background work of IMCC in Maharashtra. The center now runs B.Lib.I.Sc., M.lib.I.Sc., BCA programme of YCMOU in IMCC.

MES IMCC's IGNOU Study Centre

The IGNOU Study Center 16142 runs MBA, MTTM, MLIS, BLIS, BTS, BCA, CBS, CIT, CNM, PGDLAN programmes; during the last academic year CLS(Certificate programme of Library Science) was introduced in the study center. As on date total ---- learners are studying from the IGNOU SC 16142 of MES IMCC, Pune.

The centre was established in 2014(September). Dr Santosh Deshpande is working as the Head of the IGNOU SC 16142 and Dr.Mrs.Meenal Oak took the charge of IGNOU Study Centre -16142 from January 2015 as a Study Centre Coordinator.
