During the second stage the WEB Libraries OPAC designing of MES is done for effective accessibility. The library databases of MES involved in the project can be accessible through the web now. The current arrivals, status of the document, collection and availability can be easily accessed through this MES Libraries Web OPAC.


Execution work: MES KOHA Project

- Trace out the problems faced by the member libraries involved in MES KOHA project and take the required action to solve the problems





Digital Library Section

The library has developed a digital library section for the entire user community, especially the student segment. The digital library section provides access to the online databases and IMCC's Digital Institutional repository which consists of accessibility of the Summer Projects in e-format, question papers, syllabi, prints of the research papers etc. It has now focused on building up the photo collection of the organization. Library expansion

An extension of the IMCC library has been done during this year for accommodating the expanding collection and specially to provide the additional space to the students to cater to their varied needs.

A special discussion hall is provided to the students for the project discussions. Apart form that, a research cell is designed for the research scholars and the guides in the research centre. The library also has created now Vivekanand section for the readers; the section includes a special collection on Vivekanand.

A faculty cell is also created for providing additional space for reading to the faculty members in IMCC. Thus the newly designed structure of the library is as follows:

During the last academic year, the entire collection of the books is rearranged by redesigning the shelving plan. The collection is now rearranged to accommodate newer subjects and the books purchased and to create more ease of use to the library users. Accordingly the guide boards are reworked and mounted.

LIBRARY ACTIVITIES

User Orientation

The basic purpose of this activity is to raise the awareness level of the newly entrant students regarding the library services, resources and the library rules and regulations for maximizing the usage of library. Library Orientation for freshers was conducted during the academic year 2017-18.

The library staff provides guidance to locate reading material and also to locate proper information form the library collection which helps the users in quick retrieval of the documents.

Library Kit

The library every year distributes the "Library Kit" to the newly entrant students consisting of manuals of Library Facilities and Services, Library Rules, along with current year Borrowers Tickets. It facilitates users to get acquainted with the library environment.

BEST PRACTICES

The library has focused Benchmarking Technique followed by Continuous Improvement Principle. It has adopted innovative library services which are the best. The Libraries are coping up the present scenario.

Training to LIS-professionals in MES Institutions

IMCC has conducted 2 days KOHA Library Software training program for the select LIS professionals in the MES Institutions on 23rd and 24th November, 2017. The time scheduled was from 10.00 am to 5.00 pm in the MCA Lab of MES's IMCC, at Mayur Colony Kothrud, Pune

The training was attended by a total 11 candidates from the 6 academic institutions of MES.

- 1. MES, Institute of Management and Career Courses (IMCC), Kothrud
- 2. MES, Nursing College, Chiplun
- 3. MES Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Chiplun
- 4. MES, Adya Krantiveer Vasudev Balvant Phadke Vidyalaya, Raigad

- 6. MES Balshikshan School, Mayur Colony

On the first day, the modules mainly acquisition, administration, serials, cataloguing, web-opac were considered and training was given for the implementation of the same . On the next day the modules such as circulation, web-opac and serials were focused for the purpose of training. The training programme initiated with an Inaugural function and the chief guest was Dr Santosh Deshpande, Secretary, MES. The programme was inaugurated by Dr Mrs Meenal Oak, Coordinator, KOHA Project MES and Ms Triveni from Informatics, Bangalore. Dr Mrs Meenal Oak offered a warm welcome to the participants. During the inaugural programme session, the present scenario in the libraries of academic institutions of MES was studied in the light of automation by KOHA. The coordinator advised the participants for the entire participation in the KOHA project as far as data uploading was concerned. Dr. Santosh Deshpande provided valuable suggestions time to time as far as the KOHA Project was concerned. On the second day after the training sessions, the valedictory session was conducted at the end of the programme. Dr. Vikas Inamdar was the chief guest for the session. He highlighted the importance of library automation and the newly evolved autonomous programs of library science in MES IMCC. Dr. Meenal Oak highlighted various mile stones in the process of library automation in MES institutions form the beginning to as on date.

After the session, the coordinator of MES KOHA Project Dr Mrs Meenal Oak, chalked out the future mile stones to achieve. The programme ended with the feedback session of the participants, where the requirements difficulties were discussed along with the necessary action plan.

Continuous assessment:

The Library has focused on continuous assessment of the library services by using the LIBQUAL+ technique. The users' responses are regularly collected and the feedback analysis is done every year for the last 7 years by using the questionnaire technique as well as through informal discussions and observation technique.

Efforts have been made to implement the suggestions of the user segments.

Effective use of ICT: open source library software application

The accessibility to information and the changing user expectations due to ICT has a tremendous impact on the libraries. The IMCC Library is continuously adopting the newer ways to cope with the changing scenario and particularly the extended and everchanging expectations of the tech-savy users of computer and management science. The Library is rendering presently the services through the effective use of technology such as rendering services through the cloud computing technique which includes effective utilization of KOHA open source library automation software, digital institutional repository –use of d-space open source library software, on-line accessibility of the databases on the campus, research orientation, plagiarism testing, computerised SDI, Internet search for 12 hours on the working days of the institution.

Utilization of social networking:

The library is now utilizing the social networking sites such as facebook, google pages for developing the library blog and the FB page to stimulate the use of the library and to create a strong communication link with the IMCC alumni members.

Use of "turnitin": antiplagiarism policy:

The Ph.D. research Centre of MES's IMCC is equipped with the required software "turnitin", and the MES's IMCC Library is playing a vital role in quality testing and originality using the turnitin software to the research papers of MES's IMCC through the report of originality. As Savitribai Phule Pune University has adopted anti-plagiarism policy to detect instances of plagiarism and thereby prevent the students from publishing, presenting and copying others' research work as their own.; all the Ph.D. and M. Phil students are therefore required to attach original report of the Turnit-in Software before submission of the thesis to the Admission Section or Submission of Dissertation to the concerned research centre. The report is now one of the important requirements for initiating the further assessment procedure.

MES IMCC took lead and launched 2 programmes namely SET/NET Training Programme and Post Graduate Diploma in Digital Library Management, Automation & Networking (PGDLIMAN) an autonomous post graduate programme for the LIS professionals particularly in the Maharashtra state.

SET/NET Training Programme

IMCC started the SET/NET training programme from the year 2015. The 6th batch of the SET NET training programme started from 12th August 2018. The basic objective of this programme is to provide proper guidance to the fellow library professionals, and prepare them for the SET/NET Examination by the systematic conduction of the theory and MCQ's sessions. Enthusiasm and quest for knowledge of earlier batches has encouraged us to continue with our efforts of providing training for SET/NET examinations for the benefit of the library science profession. PGDLIMAN

IMCC has launched the Post Graduate Diploma in Digital Library Management, Automation & Networking (PGDLIMAN) in September 2017. It is an autonomous programme of MES's IMCC. It aims at developing the professional competencies of the library and information professionals in an automated and digital library networked environment. The first batch successfully completed the programme; the second batch is being conducted in the centre.

The program focuses on in-depth practical sessions for building the technological skills of the students supported by required sessions on the theory, in order to develop them as an independent library manager who will manage the library in the new era successfully. The Libraries today are impacted tremendously by the digital and networked environment. ICT has a major impact on the storage functions and delivery of information in the library. The task ahead is a major challenge to handle the voluminous data in the digitized form and to manage it successfully for serving the user segments in an effective manner.

The objectives of the programme are to imbibe knowledge of the basic requirements of library automation and automated library services with the major focus on Open Source Library Software systems such as D-space and KOHA; to provide knowledge and skills on networking and Internet technology in particular to the library and information networks; to develop the Internet skills with special focus on the information resources available in different forms and subjects; to provide the knowledge and skills of web designing and legal issues associated with electronic information; to enable to design and develop a programme by enhancing skills on programming based on the language C++; to undertake a practical based project in order to specialize in one of the thrust areas on library automation and networking.

The Programme is of high benefit to the qualified Librarians and all other working library professionals as well as the budding LIS candidates interested in upgrading the ICT knowledge, skills and its effective application in the current automated and networked library environment. The programme is open to candidates with a minimum Bachelor's Degree in Library and Information Science (BLISc).

YCMOU STUDY CENTRE

Since last year the MES's IMCC ia been approved as a YCMOU centre to run the academic programs in the Computer and Library science.
