


The awarness session was conducted by Mrs. Ghatpande madam of Urmi Team for all our BBA-CA, MCA and MBA students.


### URMI : RED DOT INITIATIVE

These events not only enhanced the involvement and motivation of students but also filled the gap between the faculty and students which was created during online teaching.






#### YOGA DAY


### **TECH STACK**

#### G-20 and India's Presidency

"India's G20 Presidency will work to promote this universal sense of oneness. Hence our theme - 'One Earth, One Family, One Future'" – PM Narendra Modi.

#### "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam"

#### What is G20?

The Group of Twenty (G20) is an intergovernmental forum comprising 19 countries - Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, the Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, United Kingdom and the United States and the European Union.

The G20 members represent around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the global trade, and about two-thirds of the world population.

The G20 was founded in 1999 after the Asian financial crisis as a forum for Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors to discuss global economic and financial issues. It was upgraded to the level of Heads of State/Government in the wake of the global economic and financial crisis of 2007, and, in 2009, was designated the "premier forum for international economic cooperation".

#### What is the G20 Summit?

The G20 Summit is held annually, under the leadership of a rotating Presidency.

#### How does the G20 work?

The G20 Presidency steers the G20 agenda for one year and hosts the Summit. The G20 consists of two parallel tracks: the **Finance Track** and the **Sherpa Track**. Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors lead the Finance Track, while Sherpas lead the Sherpa Track.

#### India's G -20 Presidency

India holds the Presidency of the G20 from December 1, 2022, to November 30, 2023. The 43 Heads of Delegations- the largest ever in G20-will be participating in the final New Delhi Summit in September next year.

The **G20 Logo** draws inspiration from the vibrant colors of India's national flag – saffron, white and green, and blue. It juxtaposes planet Earth with the lotus, India's national flower that reflects growth amid challenges. The Earth reflects India's pro-planet approach to life, one in perfect harmony with nature. Below the G20 logo is "Bharat", written in the Devanagari script.

The theme of India's G2O Presidency - "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" or "One Earth  $\cdot$  One Family  $\cdot$  One Future" - is drawn from the ancient Sanskrit text of the Maha Upanishad. Essentially, the theme affirms the value of all life – human, animal, plant, and microorganisms – and their interconnectedness on the planet Earth and in the wider universe. The theme also spotlights LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment), with its associated, environmentally sustainable, and responsible choices, both at the level of individual lifestyles as well as national development, leading to globally transformative actions resulting in a cleaner, greener and bluer future.

For India, the G20 Presidency also marks the beginning of "Amritkaal", the 25-year period beginning from the 75th anniversary of its independence on 15 August 2022, leading up to the centenary of its independence, towards a futuristic, prosperous, inclusive, and developed society, distinguished by a human-centric approach at its core.

A new working group on Disaster Risk Reduction will be established under India's Presidency to encourage collective work by the G20, undertake multi-disciplinary research, and exchange best practices on disaster risk reduction.

India's special invitee guest countries are Bangladesh, Egypt, Mauritius, Netherlands, Nigeria, Oman, Singapore, Spain, and UAE.

G-20's invited international organizations are the UN, IMF, World Bank, WHO, WTO, ILO, FSB, OECD, AU Chair, NEPAD Chair, ASEAN Chair, ADB, ISA, and CDRI.

#### पराक्रमाला माथ्यावरचे अथांग नभ अपुरे

ज्ञानप्रबोधिनी म्हणजे पुण्यातील एक नामांकित शाळा ! मी 7 वी पासून निगडीच्या ज्ञानप्रबोधिनी मध्ये शिकत होतो.

> राष्ट्रार्थ भव्य कृती काही पराक्रमाची | ईर्षा निजान्तरी धारूनी करावयाची ||

या ओळींमधील आशयाप्रमाणे आपले ध्येय असले पाहीजे ,याच ध्येया ने आम्ही ज्ञानप्रबोधिनीतील विविध उपक्रमानी झपटल्यागत झालो होतो . 9 व्या आणि 10 व्या वर्गात शिकत असतानाच पुणे ते गोवा ,पुणे ते वाई ,पुणे ते अलिबाग अशी सायकल सहल झाली होती , आता आमच्या शाळेतील शिक्षकानी पुणे ते कन्याकुमारी असे 1700 किमी सायकल ने जायचे ठरविले होते मला प्रथम थोडे आश्चर्य च वाटले कारण एवढा मोठा सायकल प्रवास कसा करायचा ,मना मध्ये थोडी शंका ,भीती होती , तेव्हा मी 11 वी सायन्स (2017) मध्ये शिकत होतो. म्हणजे शाळेचा माझी विद्यार्थी ! शिक्षकानी आमच्या वर मोठी जवाबदारी टाकली होती . 7 वी ते 9 वी च्या विद्यार्थी चे तुम्ही नेतृत्व करून ही सायकल सहल पूर्ण करायची आहे.

मग या सायकल सहलीची पूर्व तयारी म्हणून 3/4 महीने आधी पासूनच आमचा सराव सुरू झाला . रोज किमान 30-40 किमी आम्ही सायकलवर पुण्याजवळच्या वेगवेगळ्या ठिकाणी जावून यायचो आणि रविवारी 100 किमी सायकल चालवणे व्हायचे. त्यासोबत रस्त्यात सायकल खराब झाली तर ती दुरुस्त कशी करायची याचेही प्रशिक्षण दिले होते. त्यामुळे मनावर कोणताही तणाव नव्हता ,रोज उत्साह वाढत होता.

आमचे शिक्षक पुणे ते कन्याकुमारी असा पायलट टुर करून आले होते ,या सायकल प्रवासाला 17 दिवस लागणार होते ,रोज किमान 100 किमी सायकललिंग करायचे ,रात्री कुठे थांबायचे ,दोन वेळचे जेवण ,नाश्ता कूठे करायचा हे सर्व ठरले होते...

अखेर सायकल प्रवासाचा तो सुवर्णदिवस उगवला, ज्ञानप्रबोधिनी गुरुकुलला 20 वर्षे पूर्ण झाली म्हणून हा विशेष उपक्रम होता आणि पर्यावरणाचा एक महत्वपूर्ण संदेश देण्यासाठी आम्ही 50 जन सज्ज झालो. आमचे 6 गट केले होते ,4 गट मुलांचे तर 2 गट मुलींचे . एका गटात प्रत्येकी 6-7 जण होते.

25 डिसेंबर 2017 सकाळची प्रचंड थंडी ,सकाळचे 5 वाजले होते ,सर्वांचे पालक आपापल्या मुलांना शुभेच्छा व निरोप देण्यासाठी जमा झाले होते. शाळेतील शिक्षक तसेच 150-200 पालक जण आमचा उत्साह वाढवीत होते. आणि आम्ही सर्वांचा निरोप घेऊन पुण्यातून निघालो.

आमचा पहिला मुक्काम सातारा येथे होता.पहिल्या दिवशी 100-125 किमी अंतर पार केले ,दुसऱ्या दिवशी पान जवळपास तेवढेच अंतर पार करून आम्ही कोल्हापूर येथे दूसरा मुक्काम केला. आणि नंतर तिसऱ्या दिवशी महाराष्ट्राच्या बाहेर पडलो.

6 गटा न मध्ये आमचा गट सर्वात पुढे होता. रात्रीच्या मुक्कामा नंतर सकाळी आवरून 6 वाजता आम्ही निघायचो, वाटेतच 8-9 वाजे दरम्यान नाश्ता साठी थांबायचो आणि दुपारी 1 वाजे च्या दरम्यान जेवणासाठी थांबायचो. संध्याकाळी अंधार पडायच्या आत नियोजित ठिकाणी पोहोचायचो असा रोजचा दिनक्रम होता.सुरुवातीचे 2-4 दिवस थकवा जाणवाला , पण नंतर ते रोजची सवय आणि सर्वांचे प्रोत्साहन होते त्यामुळे सर्वान मध्ये खूप उत्साह होता .पूर्ण 17 दिवस आमचा रोजचा असाच दिनक्रम होता.

महाराष्ट्र सोडल्यावर कर्नाटकातून जेव्हा आम्ही जात होतो , तेथील लोकाना मराठी तर येत नव्हती ते फक्त कन्नड बोलायचे,हिन्दी पण त्यांना येत नव्हते. त्यांची सुद्धा आम्हाला खूप मदत झाली ,एकदा तर सलग तास भर एका माणसाने आमचा पाठलाग केला की हे इतके सारे मुल कुठे चालले आहेत कुठून आलेत वगरे .. आम्ही दुपारी जेवणासाठी थांबलो होतो तिथून निघताना हॉटेल वाला माणूस म्हणाला एका माणसाने तुमच्या साथी हे नारळ पानी दिले आहेत ते घ्या.. कोण होता तो हे कळलेच नाही, आम्ही धन्यवाद सांगा आमचा त्यांना अस सांगून तिथून पुढे निघालो.

दुसऱ्या दिवशी सुद्धा कर्नाटक पोलीस बराच वेळ मागे होती ,कन्याकुमारी ला जातोय हे सांगितल्यावर त्यांना खूप भारी वाटले ,त्यांनी पण आमचा उत्साह वाढवला आणि शुभेच्छा दिल्या.

जाताना दक्षिणेतील भव्य दिव्य ,सुंदर कोरीवकाम असलेली मंदिरे आम्ही बघत होतो ,इतकी पुरातन मंदिरे ,किल्ले बघून स्थापत्यकलेतील अद्भुतता लक्षात येत होती मग ते मदुरई चे मीनाक्षी देवी मंदिर असो किंवा चित्रदुर्ग चा राणी चेन्नमा चा किल्ला असो. आमचा कर्नाटक मध्ये रात्रीचे मुक्काम राष्ट्रउत्थान शिक्षण संस्थेत असायचा.

असे अभूतपूर्व अनुभव घेत आम्ही 9 जानेवारी 2018 रोजी कन्याकुमारी मध्ये पोहोचलो तेथे आमचे जोरदार स्वागत झाले. पुणे ते कन्याकुमारी असा 1700 किमी चा सायकल प्रवास आमचा पूर्ण झाला ,17 दिवस सलग सायकल चालवत आम्ही तिथे पोहोचलो . दोन दिवस विवेकानंद केंद्रात आमचा मुक्काम होता ,12 जानेवारी ला विवेकानंद जयंती निमित्त व युवा दिनाच्या दिवशी 1000 सूर्यनमस्कार घातले. हा संपूर्ण अनुभव म्हणजे माझ्या साठी संपूर्ण जीवनसाठी एक अभूतपूर्व शिदोरी आहे.

While we have made a sincere effort towards the compilation of this magazine, any error is deeply regretted. We look forward to your comments and suggestions!




